Winner of the logo competition



The winner of the Eucharistic Congress Logo Competition is a young lady who hails from Siparia, Tricia Ready.

Tricia is 23 years old and is employed as a Library Assistant I at NALIS. She is currently pursuing her degree in Business Management. Ms Ready is involved in the Catechetics Ministry, Liturgy Committee and many other activities in her church La Divina Pastora.

The logo Ms Ready created comprises of a descending dove that is slowly turning into flames and carrying the Body and Blood of Christ on its back.

The dove represents the Holy Spirit descending from heaven. The flames or the tongues of fire are symbolic of the Holy Spirit, God's anointing power. The third symbol – the Eucharist is the keystone of our Catholic faith.

It represents praise, thanksgiving and forgiveness of sin won by Christ's blood shed on the cross. The metamorphosis of the dove into flames of fire is the symbolic representation of the mystery of the transfiguration of the bread and wine into the Eucharist – a sacrament of unity that binds the community together.
